Thank you for your continued support of the Plan.

We are writing to inform you of changes to the statement of investment policy of AMTD Allianz Choice Capital Stable Fund, AMTD Allianz Choice Stable Growth Fund, AMTD Allianz Choice Balance Fund and AMTD Allianz Choice Growth Fund, constituent funds of the Plan as summarized below:

- AMTD Allianz Choice Capital Stable Fund
- AMTD Allianz Choice Stable Growth Fund
- AMTD Allianz Choice Balanced Fund
- AMTD Allianz Choice Growth Fund (Each a "Constituent Fund" and collectively the "Constituent Funds")

Summary of changes:

• With effect from 15 January 2021, the statements of investment policies of AMTD Allianz Choice Capital Stable Fund, AMTD Allianz Choice Stable Growth Fund, AMTD Allianz Choice Balanced Fund and AMTD Allianz Choice Growth Fund will be revised to reflect the changes to the investment policies of their respective underlying APIFs.

The above changes will not have any adverse impact on Members.

1. Changes relating to AMTD Allianz Choice Capital Stable Fund, AMTD Allianz Choice Stable Growth Fund, AMTD Allianz Choice Balanced Fund and AMTD Allianz Choice Growth Fund

Each of the above Constituent Funds invests solely in a sub-fund of Allianz Global Investors Choice Fund ("AGI Fund") (each an "Underlying APIF" and collectively the "Underlying APIFs") as shown in the table below. The Underlying APIFs are managed by Allianz Global Investors Asia Pacific Limited ("Allianz Global Investors").

We have been informed by Allianz Global Investors that with effect from 15 January 2021, the investment policies of the Underlying APIFs will be revised as detailed below.

The Underlying APIFs are fund of funds currently investing substantially all their assets in other sub-funds of the AGI Fund (collectively the "Other APIFs") as determined by the Allianz Global Investors as the manager of the Underlying APIFs from time to time to be appropriate to provide the desired investment exposure for the relevant Underlying APIF based on its investment objective and policy.

In order to expand the investment universe of each of the Underlying APIFs, to gain access to countries and/or markets not currently covered by the existing Other APIFs and to balance investment style risk, with effect from 15 January 2021 each of the Underlying APIFs may, subject to the investment and borrowing restrictions set out in the offering documents of the Underlying APIFs, invest in index-tracking collective investment schemes approved by the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Authority ("Underlying ITCIS"), in addition to Other APIFs.

In addition, to more accurately reflect the existing flexibility of the manager of the Underlying APIFs in selecting the appropriate underlying funds for investments by the Underlying APIFs (including the Other APIFs and/or the Underlying ITCIS), references to the specific names of the Other APIFs in which each of the Underlying APIFs invests will be removed from the investment policies of the Underlying APIFs in the offering documents of the Underlying APIFs.

Based on the information provided by Allianz Global Investors, notwithstanding the above amendments to the investment policies of the Underlying APIFs, the Underlying APIFs will remain in the form of fund of funds and the investment objective of each of the Underlying APIFs will remain unchanged. Allianz Global Investors continues to have the flexibility to determine the appropriate underlying funds for investments by the Underlying APIFs. The above amendments to the investment policies of the Underlying APIFs do not amount to any

material changes to the AGI Fund and each of the Underlying APIFs. The fee level of the AGI Fund and each of the Underlying APIFs will remain unchanged. The amendments to the investment policies will not result in any material changes or increase in the overall risk profile of the Underlying APIFs, and will not have any adverse impact on the rights or interests of their investors.

In this connection, with effect from 15 January 2021, paragraphs "(a) Objective", "(b) Balance of investments", (c) "Security lending and repurchase agreements" and (d) "Futures and options" of the statements of investment policy of the relevant Constituent Funds as set out in the MPF Scheme Brochure will be amended by way of the Second Addendum as shown in Appendix hereto to reflect the corresponding changes to the investment policies of the Underlying APIFs as described above.

The changes to the Underlying APIFs and consequentially the Constituent Funds set out above do not and will not have any adverse impact on Members. The costs and expenses incurred in preparing and issuing this Notice and the Second Addendum are borne by the Plan.

AMTD Allianz Choice Capital Stable Fund
